How to Complete a Mary Sky Residency Application

Step 1: Fill out this form and compile with requested materials. Please submit images with at least 300dpi. Video and work existing on the web may be included as a link in your application. In this case, we request that you also include images. These could be anything from screenshots to images of installations or events. Choose images you feel will best represent your practice to our evaluators.

Step 2: Email the compiled PDF application with your full name and “Residency Application” in the subject line to: artists@marysky.co

Step 3: Pay the Administrative Fee on our site. marysky.co/apply

The culmination or outcome of this residency is ultimately up to you. We make every attempt to work with each artist to realize what they would like to achieve.
